# Septagon Construction Career Day Rules & Regulations

- 1. CONTRACT OBLIGATIONS:** No exhibitor will be permitted to set up their booth until all fees are paid in full.
- 2. EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY RIGHT OF REFUSAL AND/OR CANCELLATION:** Septagon Construction reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any exhibitor. In the event of non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned to the applicant. Once the applicant has been accepted, the full cost of the exhibit space is due and payable in the manner described in the fee schedule. Exhibits and the conduct of exhibitors are subject to Septagon approval, which reserves the right to refuse the application of any company not meeting the required standards, as well as the right to curtail exhibits or parts of exhibits that detract from the character of the show. This also applies to displays, literature, advertising, novelties, souvenirs, and personal conduct of exhibitors. Officers, employees, and agents involved in the management of the Construction Career Day shall have full authority to interpret and enforce all rules and regulations governing Exhibitors. All matters and questions not specifically addressed in the rules shall be subject to final determination by Septagon. The rules may be amended at any time by Septagon upon notice to Exhibitors. In addition to any other recourse referenced in these rules and regulations, Septagon may have recourse for the violation of any of these rules in any manner it deems appropriate, including expulsion of an exhibitor from the event and suspension from future shows.
- 3. EXHIBIT SPACE:** For each designated space, Septagon shall provide one 8' table and two folding chairs. Booth signage will be the responsibility of the vendor.
- 4. MOVE IN:** A forklift and Septagon operator are available to be used during move in and tear down. Please come prepared with any equipment you need to help move your product.
- 5. UNOCCUPIED SPACE:** If the exhibitor fails to occupy space contracted for by 8 am on event day, or fails to comply in any respect with the terms of these rules and regulations, Septagon shall have the right to rent such space to any other applicant without releasing the original exhibitor from paying the sum agreed to in the application and contract for exhibit space.
- 6. FIRE SAFETY:** No combustible oils or gases may be used as part of the exhibit, nor will any open flames be permitted without prior written approval of the Fire Marshall. All electrical equipment used in conjunction with the display's installation, operation, and dismantling must be in good operating condition and able to pass the inspection of the local Fire Marshall. Storage of excess materials in hallways is prohibited.
- 7. HELIUM BALLOONS:** Exhibitors cannot utilize helium balloons as décor or a part of their booth, per facility rules and regulations.
- 8. CARE OF EXHIBIT SPACE:** Each exhibitor must keep their own space cleaned and their exhibit maintained in good order while the event is open.
- 9. ELECTRIC NEEDS:** Access to 110V service will be supplied to those exhibitors who request when registering for their exhibit space located inside the building. **Exhibitors will need to bring their own extensions cords to use.**
- 10. EVENTUALITIES:** In case the exhibit hall should be destroyed by fire or the elements, or by another cause, or in case other circumstance shall make it impossible for Septagon to permit the contracted space to be occupied by exhibitor, the application and contract for exhibit space shall terminate and the exhibitor shall waive any claim for damages or compensation.
- 11. LIABILITY:** Neither Septagon, the employees thereof, their agents or representatives; nor the Missouri State Fair Ground facilities, the employees thereof, their agents or representatives shall be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to the exhibitor, or to the exhibitor's employees or property from any cause whatsoever prior, during or subsequent to the period covered by the application and contract for exhibit space; and the exhibitor on signing the contract expressly releases the foregoing named Corporation, Individuals, their agents and employees from any and all claims for use loss, damage, or injury.
- 12. SET-UP OF EXHIBITS:** Hours for set-up of exhibits are Wednesday, April 12th, 2023 from 8 am until 5 pm.
- 13. EVENT TIME:** The event will be open to students beginning at 8 am until 2 pm on Thursday, April 13th, 2023.
- 14. TEAR DOWN OF EXHIBIT:** All exhibits must remain set-up until 2 pm on Thursday. Tear down will not begin until after 2 pm. All exhibits must be removed by 2 pm on Thursday.
- 15. BOOTH ASSIGNMENTS:** Septagon reserves the right to change or alter space assignments, floor plans, and show conditions without notice and at their sole discretion for the best interest of the event.
- 16. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS:** Exhibitors shall comply with all local, city, state and federal safety, fire and health laws, ordinances and regulations, including the policies, rules and regulations of the Missouri State Fair Facilities regarding the installation, dismantling and operation of the exhibit.
- 17. COPYRIGHTED WORKS:** Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that is shall be solely responsible for obtaining and licenses, permits, etc., which may be required to it to broadcast, perform, or display and copyrighted materials including, but not limited to, music, video, and software. Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Septagon and its directors, offices, employees and agents from and against any and all claims and expenses, including attorney's fees and costs, arising out of or related to Exhibitors breach of this provision. The terms of this provision shall survive the termination or expiration of this agreement.
- 18. AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT:** Exhibitor represents and warrants that its exhibit and product/service information shall comply with the American with Disabilities Act, its regulations, and guidelines (Collectively ADA). Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Septagon and it directors, officers, employees and agents from and against any and all claims and expenses, including attorneys fees and costs, arising out of or related to Exhibitors breach of this provision or noncompliance with any provision of the ADA.

# Septagon Construction Career Day Rules & Regulations continued

19. **LEGAL ACTION:** Any legal action by an exhibitor against Septagon related to these rules must be brought in Circuit Court of Pettis County, Missouri, and Exhibitor's sole remedy is limited to exhibition fees actually paid by the exhibitor, and indirect or consequential damages any not be sought. Should any litigation arise out of this event, the Exhibitor shall pay all costs and reasonable attorney's fees incurred by Septagon and/or the co-sponsoring agencies if they are the prevailing party.
20. **INSURANCE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENTS:** Each exhibitor is required to have Public Liability Insurance to protect against possible claims arising out of the operation of this exhibit—this includes coverage for allowing students to operate equipment. **A CERTIFICATION OF INSURANCE SHOWING THIS COVERAGE AND INCLUDING SEPTAGON AS PRIMARY NONCONTRIBUTING ADDITIONAL INSURED ON THE GENERAL LIABILITY, AUTO LIABILITY AND UMBRELLA LIABILITY, ALONG WITH A WAIVER OF SUBROGATION ON ALL COVERAGES, AS ALLOWED BY LAW MUST ACCOMPANY THE CONTRACT IN ORDER TO RESERVE SPACE AT CONSTRUCTION CAREER DAY.** Fire, theft, liability and extended coverage insurance is not provided by Septagon or Missouri State Fair facilities. Exhibitor must obtain such coverage at its own expense. Exhibitor remains responsible for all property brought into the event and shall bear the sole risk of loss for that property. Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless Septagon and its directors, agents and employees from any damages whatsoever, as well as for all claims, losses, liability, or damages for injury, death, or property damage that may arise from activities of the exhibitor, its employees, agents, invitees, and licensees.
21. **DEFACEMENT OF THE FACILITY:** Exhibitor shall not in any manner injure, mar or deface the facility or any equipment contained therein, and shall not cause or permit anything to be done such that the facility has sustained damage. Exhibitor shall not drive or permit to be driven any nails, hooks, tacks or screws into any part of the facility or equipment contained therein; will not make or allow to made an alterations of any kind to the facility or equipment contained therein; and will not affix or permit to be affixed by adhesives to the facility or equipment contained therein any signs, posters, notices or graphics of any descriptions without the prior written consent of MSF.
22. **FLAMMABLE MATERIALS:** All flammable materials used for decorative purposes must be approved by the MSF. Unless exhibitor has the prior written consent of MSF and Septagon, exhibitor shall not operate any engine, motor or machinery us oils, burning fluids, camphene, kerosene, naphtha, or gasoline or any other flammable chemical for other mechanical or other purpose nor use any agent other than electricity for lighting.
23. **Exhibitor hereby represents and warrants to Septagon that the exhibitor has taken all steps reasonably necessary to ensure the sound engineering and structural integrity in its exhibit design and the proper construction and safety of the exhibit itself, as erected.**
24. **AMENDMENTS:** Septagon has full power to interpret or amend these rules. Whatever these rules do not cover, Septagon reserves the right to make rules to cover to be in the best interest of the event, and the exhibitor agrees to accept and abide by such rulings.
25. **PENALTIES:** The penalty for violation of any rule CAN result in immediate booth closure and suspension of exhibitor's right to be in the next year's show.
26. **OBSTRUCTIONS:** Exhibitor agrees not to allow any sidewalks, entries, passage vestibules, halls, elevators or access ways of the Facility to be obstructed or permitted to be used for any purpose other than ingress or egress to and from the facility. Licensee shall not cause or allow any of the doors, skylights, stairway or openings that reflect or admit light into any portion of the facility to be obstructed.
27. **PHYSICAL GROUNDS:** Exhibitor is not to drill, or allow the drilling of, any holes into any area of the grounds, or make an alterations to the grounds or facilities.
28. **RESTRICTIONS ON ADMISSION TO FACILITY:** Exhibitor agrees that no patron shall be admitted to the Facility in the possession of any outside food, beverage (alcoholic or non-alcoholic), illegal drugs, controlled substances or animals. Additionally, no bundles or containers of any kind including, but not limited to bags, ice chests, backpacks, cans, bottles, camera cases and binocular cases, may be brought into the facility. MSF and/or Septagon reserves the right to inspect any pocketbooks, purses, coats, blankets, etc. being brought into the facility. Exhibitor shall not permit the facility to used for lodging rooms, or for any improper, immoral or objectionable purposes.
29. **WIFI/INTERNET SERVICES:** WIFI is not included for the event. Exhibitors will need to use their personal device hotspot to obtain WIFI during the event.
